- 1. Call to Order** – The Storm Water Drainage Commission was called to order by B. Eastman at 1:00pm.
- 2. Public Comment** – None
- 3. Adoption of the March 14, 2019 meeting minutes** – K. Kryger motioned to approve the March 14, 2019 minutes, W. Riley seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.
- 4. Crystal Drive Culvert Lining-Proposal from A.W. Oakes** – The Commission was provided with a quote for \$22,675 from A.W. Oakes & Son to install a Snap- Tite liner system in the severely deteriorated culvert in the Spring Green subdivision. R. Pritzlaff addressed the Commission on the basement flooding issues the property owner at 7939 Crystal Dr. has been having. The Village would like to line the culvert to ensure proper flow and cannot replace the culvert due to fencing and easement issues. K. Kryger motioned to approve the quote from A.W. Oakes & Son as presented, J. Mandala seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.
- 5. Hood’s Creek Culvert Crossing Repair-North of Louis Sorenson Road** - R. Borgardt, D. Zenner & G. Zenner provided photos and addressed the Commission regarding the issues with a collapsing culvert on their properties. The Commission would like the Village to investigate the issues with the culvert.
- 6. Discussion and Next Steps-Miscellaneous District Drain Tile Exploration and Repair** - L. Weber addressed the Commission on the District Drain Tile complaints in the Village.  
**Willow Road-** Staff will monitor the area after a rain event. If surcharging continues, more collapses/blockages may exist downstream that require repair. If surcharging has stopped, the residential lots with holes from previous blowouts may need to have the tile excavated.  
**Shorehaven-** T. Carcelli of Shorehaven Ln addressed the Commission regarding the ongoing concern with a drain tile that discharges near the top of the bluff on his property.  
The Village staff will meet onsite to discuss options for relocating the discharge point at the bluff.  
**Kraut Rd. – Joint Project with Caledonia** – Tiles have been traced and marked with flags/paint. A meeting will be scheduled soon between both municipalities to discuss plans going forward.  
**Kraut Rd.** – Resident on Kraut Rd is having drainage issues with a district drain tile. Due to high water the site has not been visited by Village staff. Updates will be provided once the site can be inspected.  
**Spring St.** – Resident on Spring St. is having drainage issues with a district drain tile. A site visit was recently completed but the Village Engineering Department where two blowouts in need of repair were found. The Highway Department is going to do a site visit as well and evaluate whether or not this repair can be completed by Village staff, or if it will need to be contracted out.
- 7. March Vouchers** – J. Mandala motioned to approve the March Vouchers in the amount of \$309,435.89, W. Riley seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.
