January 13, 2022

1. **Call to Order** - The Public Works Committee was called to order by B. Eastman at 9:00 AM.
2. **Public Comment** - None
3. **Adoption of Public Works Committee November 11, 2021 Meeting Minutes** - J. Schneider motioned to adopt the November 11, 2021 meeting minutes as presented, F. Risler seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
4. **Presentation by Sam Schultz – Review of Revisions to New Village Subdivision Ordinance** – S. Schultz presented the Committee with updates to sections 2.5.3.4, 3.10, 4.2.6, and 7.10 of the new Village Subdivision Ordinance. D. Anastasio motioned to approve the Chapter 74: Land Division - 2021 Update, F. Risler seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
5. **Consideration of Additions to 2022 Paving Program** – The Committee was provided with the draft 2022 schedule for the Village road resurfacing. The 2022 Paving Program was initially presented prior to the budget and the Village Board decided to allow for more funding. Staff requested nine additional sections of road be added to the paving program. F. Risler motioned to approve the Additions to the 2022 Paving Program as presented, D. Anastasio seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
6. **Discussion of Village Road Weight Restrictions – Sec. 78-191 of the Village Code of Ordinances** – Staff would like to update Section 78 due to outdated parking restrictions and weight limits. The proposed changes would be to remove nine locations from section 78-191. J. Schneider motioned to approve the proposed modifications to 78-191 as presented, F. Risler seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
7. **Discussion of Village Road Parking Restrictions – Sec. 78-142 of the Village Code of Ordinances** - The construction is now complete on Oakes Rd. and Staff would like to revisit the restrictions due to the new traffic pattern. M. Benish believes that there should be no parking on either side of the street on Oakes Rd. between STH20 and 16th St. J. Schneider motioned to approve to proposed modifications to 78-142 on Oakes Road, south of STH20 terminating at 16th Street be restricted to driving only, D. Anastasio seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
8. **Committee and Staff Reports**
 - **T. Beyer - Oakes Road Reconstruction** – The project is substantially complete and went very well. The contractor and Engineers did a great job with the design, working with a revised schedule and safety considerations.
9. **Adjourn** - F. Risler motioned to adjourn the Public Works Committee meeting at 9:23 AM. D. Anastasio seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
