Public Works Committee Meeting Minutes

July 14, 2022

1. **Call to Order** – The Public Works Committee Meeting was called to order by F. Risler at 9:05 AM.
2. **Public Comment** – O. Aguilar & G. Peterson (Youth for Christ at 3001 Carpenter Ave.) expressed their concerns with erosion caused by parking at the property across the street. During snow falls the debris is pushed onto their property. They are looking for solutions and wondering if it is possible for a curb to be installed.
3. **Adoption of Public Works Committee May 12, 2022 Meeting Minutes** –J. Schneider motioned to approve the May 12, 2022 meeting minutes as presented, D. Anastasio seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.
4. **Discussion of Village Road Weight Restriction – Sec. 78-191 of the Village Code of Ordinances** – The Committee was presented with an outdate ordinance that has not been reviewed in several years. The roads in question have been reconstructed and no longer fall under the weight limit restrictions. Staff would like to update Section 78-191 of the Village Code accordingly. These roads would still require signage for no truck traffic.
5. **Chicory Road Signage – Weight Limit Restrictions** – CTH 11 is currently under construction which caused issues with the trucking route. Staff has been working with the county to get pre-emptive signage installed to detour truck traffic while there is still construction on CTH 11.
6. **Kinzie Avenue Reconstruction Project** – Kinzie Ave. west of Emmertsen Rd. is listed for resurfacing in 2023. The issue is that this is an old section of Kinzie Ave. that has never been resurfaced and there are major drainage issues in the area. There will need to be curb and gutter installed which would create assessments for property owners and potential land acquisition.
7. **Committee and Staff Reports**
 - **Director of Public Works - None**
 - **Deputy Director of Public Works - 2022 BIL Funding Application** – Two applications were submitted for grant funding, one for Chicory Rd. and the other for Lathrop Ave. potentially totaling 21 million. A decision on the projects should be made by the end of this month. Lathrop Ave. would be the priority project for funding.
 - **2022 Pre-Disaster Mitigation Grant** – Staff initially submitted an application for grant funding in December of 2020. The Village was selected and approved for approximately 1.6 million but a second application needs to be submitted to receive the funding.

- **2022 Paving Program** – The majority of the paving has been completed. There are several roads that are currently under construction.
- **90th St. Resurfacing** – This is a joint project with the Village of Sturtevant and is scheduled to start early August.

- **Public Works Superintendent - None**

8. Adjourn – D. Anastasio motioned to adjourn the Public Works Committee meeting at 9:30 AM, J. Schneider seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0.
