May 7th, 2015

1. **Call to Order-** Public Committee meeting called to order by R. McCluskey at 9:00 a.m.
2. **Public Comment-** Resident Mike Kennedy spoke on behalf of the Green Haze Avenue area regarding the project of reconstruction, curb & gutter proposals, present restricted parking and the issue of possible loss of trees. Also discussed was the long-term maintenance.
3. **Adoption of the April 9th, 2015 minutes-** M. Callewaert motioned to adopt the April 9th, 2015 Public Works meeting minutes. S. Havn seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.
4. **Approval of 2015 Paving Program—22nd Street Design Elements/Alternatives-** B. Sasse discussed direction of proposed amenities and explained handout exhibits the design estimates for the 22nd Street project and requested feedback from the Public Works Committee. B. Sasse suggested installation of bumpouts to calm & slow traffic through the intersection and possible placement of signage. B. Sasse proposed possible less travel distance for pedestrians and reduction of other safety issues. Committee requested roll call voting on all proposed amenities, including proposed lighting & bumpouts and are attached. Motion not to include the lighting or bumpouts, not full, but partial sidewalk replacement. Committee voted All in favor; motion carried 4-0.
5. **Recommendation to Approve a Racine/Mount Pleasant Joint Engineering/Construction Management Agreement for 2015 Paving Program—22nd Street Reconstruction-** Also discussed to be included in the 22nd Street Design is the sidewalk 1 block north of Zoe Industries. The sidewalk is badly broken and in need of replacement. Committee request for the sidewalk be included in the project & also requested a policy be put into place and the costs be assessed back to the property owners. R. McCluskey recommended repairing the sidewalk due to liability. S. Havn motioned to include 21st Street sidewalk repairs with the 22nd Street Reconstruction project. M. Callewaert seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.
6. **2015 Paving Program: Green Haze Avenue recommendation and Report of Public Input with Approval of Design Elements/Alternatives-** Exhibits presented displayed the existing trees. The existing pavement is not in the center of the right-of-way, with shifted pavement of estimated 5 ft. off center. Engineers will make the adjustments upon review.
7. **Engineer's Reports:**

- **2015 Paving Program Recycle Contract Status-** B. Sasse stated the 2015 Paving Program Recycle Contract had been awarded to Payne & Dolan with alternatives. Plans are to move forward and to advertise bid by the end of the month.
 - **2015 Paving Program: 22nd Street Reconstruct Design Status-** Update previously discussed.
 - **CMAQ—Pike River Pathway Paving Update-** B. Sasse stated the concrete pads are in place on Phase 4. S. Havn stated a required final payment of CMAQ Paving project is due June 16th, 2015.
8. **Communications, Correspondence and Commissioner and Staff Reports-** None given.
9. **Adjournment-** M. Callewaert motioned to adjourn at 10:01 a.m. S. Havn seconded. Motion carried 4-0.
