SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

GENERAL INFORMATION

The purpose of these specifications is to relate Mt. Pleasant's requirements for purchasing the vehicle or equipment described.

The intent of these specifications is:

- To stipulate the MINIMUM acceptable requirements of good engineering design and performance.
- To establish the bidder's responsibility to furnish all necessary appurtenances and labor in supplying the equipment being advertised for, and
- To assure complete conformance by the successful bidder with the requirements outlined.

Any item omitted which is clearly necessary for the satisfactory performance of the proposed equipment, even though not directly specified, shall be considered a part of the contract.

It shall be the successful bidder's responsibility that the complete equipment conforms to all applicable State of Wisconsin and Federal safety laws, regulations and standards in effect on the date of delivery. Any party installing a body or equipment to complete a vehicle for delivery will be responsible to see that the completed vehicle meets all applicable federal motor vehicle safety standards and complies with the law in all respects.

The Village reserved the right to accept the trade-in allowance or to keep the proposed trade-in unit(s). The successful bidder agrees that any trade-in vehicle(s) or equipment will not be surrendered until the new unit(s) are in road-operable condition and in service. **Mobile Radio** equipment and any other accessory equipment noted in the trade-in unit(s) will remain the property of the Village and will be removed.

In making the award for furnishing this equipment factors other than price may be considered: such as parts, service, local and past experience with machine, adaptability to the Village's requirements, operating advantages, structural design of machine, etc.

The Village of Mt. Pleasant, through its duly authorized agents, reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive all technicalities and to accept the bid most advantageous to Village. All bidders, by submission of their respective bids, agree to abide by the rules, regulations and procedures of the Village of Mt. Pleasant.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS (Continued)

If the Vendor meets the minimum specification a "YES" shall be entered on the provided line as well as any quantitative information requested. Any exceptions or alternates to the minimum specifications shall be listed in the space provided or on a separate sheet attached. Failure to

fully complete bid package could result in the rejection of the bid. **Prices must include delivery, title registration, license plates, and transportation, preparation and handling costs.**

Award of the bid shall be based on the cost as bid for the **Total Complete Package** as specified on the Bid Proposal Form noted as Base Bid.

BIDS SHALL INCLUDE A DELIVERY DATE FROM THE TIME ORDER IS SUMMITTED.

The vehicle or equipment offered is to be of the latest type and commercial model manufactured and is to be new and unused. Manufacturer's literature covering specifications and description of the machine and equipment bid must accompany bid. The vehicle shall be furnished complete with operating accessories, modifications and equipment as specified herein. The Village reserves the right to request a demonstration of any bidders' proposed vehicle or equipment prior to issuance of a purchase order.

The term "Heavy Duty" as used to describe an item shall mean in excess of the usual quantity, quality or capacity that is normally supplied with the standard product vehicle or component.

Warranty shall start the day the vehicle is placed in service at the Public Works Department. The manufacturer shall warrant the entire vehicle or equipment any furnished devices, against parts failure or malfunction due to design, construction, installation or errors in assembly of components, defective material and workmanship.

In order to comply with the State and Federal code for vehicles, the vendor, supplier or manufacturer of applicable equipment shall upon delivery, furnish the Village of Mt. Pleasant with the following documents, if applicable, completely filled out.
