Frequency of Elections:

Even years: February, April, August, November

Odd Years: February & April

Pollworkers are assigned a duty at the polling place. Duties can include: issuing ballots to registered voters, registering voters, monitoring voting machines, explaining how to mark a ballot, counting votes, and using voting equipment.

Pollworkers are appointed to two-year terms, you will be asked to make a minimum two-year commitment. However, comitting to one election cycle (Primary & General) is also appreciated. Pollworker trainings are conducted during the year at Village Hall. The Village Clerk is required by state law to provide training. Trainings are held to provide you current and accurate information to be a successful pollworker. Chief Inspectors must receive six hours of continuing election education training during each two-year period.

To be a pollworker, a person must:

- Be a qualified elector of the county in which the municipality is located (ex: an adult citizen of the United States who has resided in the election district for 10 consecutive days and is not otherwise disqualified to vote)
- Be able to speak, read, and write fluently in the English language
- Have strong clerical skills and ability to handle stress well
- Be able to solve problems and be an effective communicator
- NOT be a candidate for any office to be voted on at the polling place at that election
