## STD Testing and Treatment

Sexually transmitted diseases (STDs) are the most common communicable diseases reported in this country. The Caledonia/Mt. Pleasant Health Department receives more reports of chlamydia and gonorrhea cases than any other reportable communicable disease. Racine County has the second highest rate of STDs in the state of Wisconsin.

If you believe you are infected with a STD, you must get tested and treated.

- Many STDs can be cured. Others cannot be cured. But all STDs can and must be treated.
- Many STDs can be treated with antibiotics. Do exactly what your provider tells you. Be sure to use all of your medicine.
- You also must tell your sexual partner(s). If they aren't treated, they can get sick. They can spread the STD. They might even give it to you again!
