## E-CYCLE EVENT

The Village is partnering with [Legacy Recycling](#) to host an electronics recycling collection event in 2023. This event takes place on September 30, 2023 from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM at Village Hall, 8811 Campus Drive. Mount Pleasant residents may drop off electronics for safe recycling and disposal. The following items are accepted:

- Computers
- Copiers
- Dehumidifiers

All TV's, monitors, microwaves, and dehumidifiers are subject to a disposal fee. All other items listed are available for recycling free of charge. Have an item not listed? Contact Legacy Recycling to see if your item is accepted. Lightbulbs and pressurized tanks such as propane tanks or fire extinguishers are not accepted.

## Attention Landscape Contractors!

You can purchase a permit for your business that allows you to dispose of compostable material at the Village Compost Site.

Municipal Code [§66-35](#) allows contractors to purchase an annual permit from the Village Clerk's Office that allows contractor use of the Village compost site. The annual permit cost is \$250.00. The permit expires

when the compost site closes for the season. Contractors are required to purchase a coupon book containing ten coupons and each coupon is \$25.00. One coupon equates to one drop-off at the compost site. Each drop-off size has a maximum of 5 yards per load. Additional coupon books may be purchased if needed. The coupons do not expire. Contact the Village Clerk's office at (262) 664-7800 for any questions.



## COMPOST SITE

The Village Compost Site is open for the season. The following items are acceptable for drop off at the site:

- Brush & Branches (max. 7' long & 4" diameter)
- Flower Plants (not in soil)
- Garden Vegetable Plants (not in soil)
- Grass Clippings
- Hay & Straw Bales (strings removed)
- Leaves
- Pine Cones
- Pumpkins

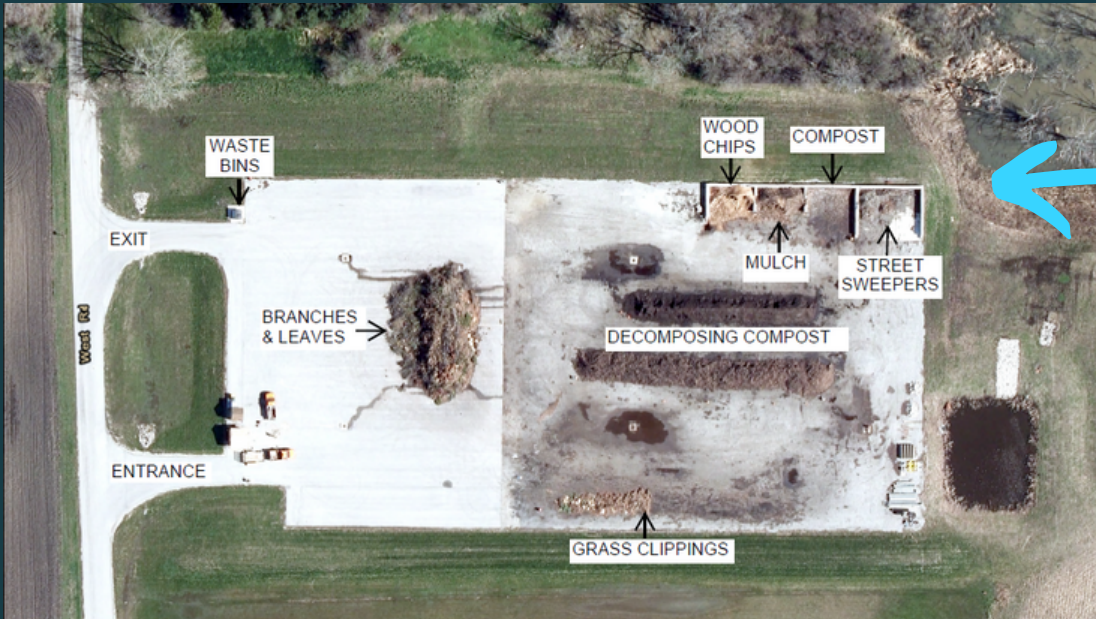

- July 15
- August 19
- September 16
- October 21

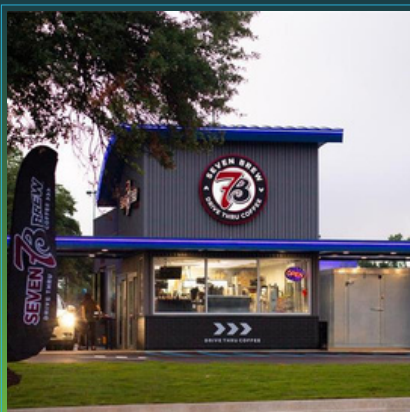



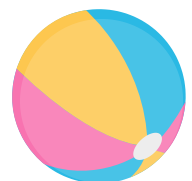
