



► **Tax Bills Posted Next Week**

The 2025 property tax bills will arrive soon in the mail, and will be online December 8. Full or first payments are due January 31. The Village is among four local governments that these tax bills support. For 2026, Village government's tax levy, not including other jurisdictions, was \$26.5 million, or a 3.1% increase over this past year. That caused a 42-cent drop in the tax rate that sets each property owner's payment to Village government based on their assessed property value. A helpful one-sheet explains the moving parts if your bill changed from last year. Details on how, where, and when to pay are on the Village website and an insert mailed with the tax bill.

► **Notice for Mailing Tax Payments**

U.S. Postal Service no longer postmarks letters the same day they are dropped in the mail. Postmarks will be applied one to three days after a letter is in a mailbox, or longer if USPS is closed for holidays or weekends. Please mail tax payments several days ahead of the actual deadlines. Other solutions include paying online, bringing envelopes to a Post Office to receive a same-day postmark at the service counter, or using Mount Pleasant Village Hall's Drop Box.
