



► **Ice Ice Safety: Stay Off Of Frozen Waterways**

South Shore Fire Department will brave the cold next week for another round of ice rescue training to be prepared in case anyone falls through the ice into a local waterway. Remember that no ice is ever 100% safe to walk upon, so stay off frozen ponds, lakes, and rivers. If someone falls through the ice, please call 911 immediately, and do not go onto the ice after them. Instead, try to extend a rope, ladder, branch, or other object to pull them out.
