Job Purpose: To perform semiskilled maintenance work in our Parks Departments.

Physical Requirements:

Performs repairs / improvements and maintains the cleanliness of parks grounds.
(Shrubs, trees and vegetation) and facility structures (restrooms, parking lots, benches).
Maintains and performs minor repair on building structures.
Maintains playground equipment and surroundings.
Cleanliness of vehicles and equipment.

Requirements of Position:

Methods and techniques of park care and operations.
Maintenance and minor repair of power equipment, vehicles, and building structures.
Methods and techniques of road maintenance repair and construction.
Basic carpentry, plumbing, masonry, painting.
Experience with small tractors, lawnmowers, residential and commercial type.
Use of power hand held tools for carpentry, plumbing, masonry.
Perform basic mathematics.
Communicate effectively orally and in writing.

Additionally:

Must be at least 18 years of age to apply.
Prompt and reliable attendance.
Work around the Public in a safe and courteous manner.
Valid Wisconsin Driver’s License.
Ability to demonstrate flexibility in the work environment, performing a variety of indoor and outdoor tasks.

Physical Requirements:

Occasional lifting of up to 50+ pounds may be required.

Working Conditions:

Requires ability to perform work under varying climatic conditions.
Monday – Friday 7:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. generally.
Some weekend and Holidays hours required.
Work period from April thru October flexible.
